CH 58: Strongest NOAA weather signal in this area. Do not transmit on this frequency.
CH 0 & 128: Since only some radios start or end with these channels, they remain unplanned. Handy spots for temporary entries in the field.
CH 74-97: Just for fun: Contributed and maintained by D.B. Lewis, KF7CYH. Suggestions welcome. Never transmit on these frequencies!
